The parties to this contract are Tulsa Indian Club, Inc. (hereafter "Host") and (hereafter "Vendor").

Whereas, Vendor has paid Host in full for an 10' x 10' booth space & the parties agree as follows:

1. Vendors must provide their own tables, chairs, display fixtures, and lighting (if desired). All must fit within the allotted space.
2. Vendor understands that no electricity or running water will be provided in their assigned area. \*Please note there will be limited booths with outlet access.
3. Vendor hereby agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Tulsa Indian Club and Cox Business Center against any and all damages or claims that may arise in connection with Vendor's presence at the Event and Vendor's activities of any kind.
4. You may not sell, imply, or otherwise lead a person to believe that your goods are authentic American Indian art or craft if you do not have a copy of your enrollment card or document available during the event. If your products are made in Mexico, Canada, or Central/South America it must be labeled as such.
5. Certificates of authenticity for artwork you are merchandising for other artists are encouraged.
6. Vendors booth shall be clean and orderly: vendors shall comply with all applicable laws and regulations.
7. No loud music, noise, and sound amplification devices shall be used by vendor or vendor staff.
8. Vendors shall have access no more than 2 hours prior to 11am each day and up to 2 hours after close of event Sunday. **Vendors will not be to start set up before 9 am Saturday.**
9. Vendors shall not vend any goods or services other than those described herein at and during the Event without the Host's written consent.
10. All vendors are required to be in compliance with the Indian Arts & Crafts Act of 1990 and the Indian Arts and Crafts Amendments of 2010. (P.L. 101-644 & P.L. 111-211).
11. Vendors will be responsible for collecting 8.517% sales tax.

I understand that the use of alcohol and or drugs is not allowed, and may result in removal from the show with NO REFUND.
