



A quick update on your House:

- The work on the second-floor balcony is complete. The new spindles (to complete the railing where the fire escape was removed) have been painted and installed.

- The carpet on the main floor has been professionally stretched so that it is smooth, attractive and safe.

- A new phone system has been ordered for the office. This replacement is not so much for new technology as it is for a reliable communication system when you reach out to the Club for reservations or information.
