



CLAY WRIGHT HORSEMANSHIP LESSONS FEBRUARY THROUGH NOVEMBER 2022

With a nod to the traditions of the Vaquero Bridle Horse and the old masters of French Classical Dressage, Clay Wright has been intuitively working with horses for 40 years.

During this time, he has started thousands of colts and worked with troubled horses. Through a unique combination of Working Ranch Horse, Classical Dressage, and Natural Horsemanship, Clay has trained horses to the finished high school level in the Vaquero Bridle as well as the Double Bridle of Classical Dressage. Solid foundational principles are necessary to producing good horsemanship regardless of your chosen riding discipline. These principles also help build a safe horse to ride and solid and rewarding connection with your horse.

Clay gives lessons one weekend every month, February – November. This schedule offers students an opportunity for growth that many one-time clinics do not. Established students may participate in small-group trail lessons that will be scheduled in the future.

Rather than teaching a
"Method" Clay prefers to teach people how to understand the horse's mental and physical state, helping the horse feel content and move with balance which allows the horse to learn and respond.
