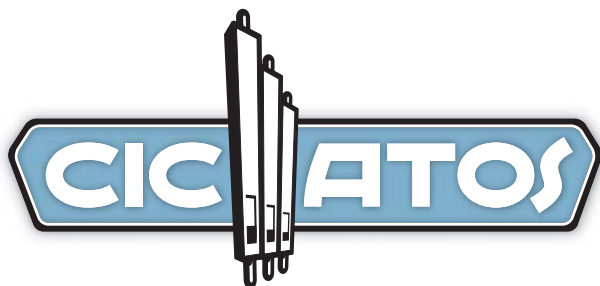

# ABOUT THE ARTIST

Pierre returns to the Warren Grande Barton with "Music & Motoring," a one-of-a-kind theatre organ concert. Enhanced with dazzling multimedia, the show will celebrate both nostalgic music and antique automobiles. The two-hour presentation will be filled with fascinating facts and video in a virtual road-trip format. Glenn Miller, George Gershwin, Cole Porter, Leroy Anderson and Irving Berlin are just some of the featured composers.

Pierre is not only a gifted theatre Organist, but a Steinway Artist - a member of a select group of exceptional pianists from around the world.

In 2014, Pierre presented a special multimedia-enhanced tribute to the late organist Buddy Cole for the ATOS Convention in Indianapolis. Highly regarded for his research and parody of Cole arrangements, Pierre marked fifty years since Buddy Cole's untimely death in 1964.

Pierre Fracalanza came to the world of theater organ quite by accident. On a fateful night about 1980, he visited Theater Organ Pizza and Pipes in Pontiac, Michigan (one of two pipe-organ-equipped restaurants in the Detroit area). With a little coaxing from organist Fr. Jim Miller, he joined the staff of the restaurant.

## CICATOS

The primary objective of the Central Indiana Chapter and the international organization—the American Theatre Organ Society—is the preservation and maintenance of the surviving theatre pipe organs from the 1920s and '30s. This effort also promotes the use, understanding and enjoyment of these unique instruments by today's generation as well as future generations.

This objective translates into a number of international and local activities that are rewarding both culturally and educationally. Membership is open to all people who enjoy listening to or creating this wonderful music. There are activities for all interest levels, including organ building and restoration enthusiasts, performers and students of theatre pipe organ.

The Central Indiana Chapter is the second largest ATOS chapter with over 300 members. CICATOS sponsors an annual concert series, comprised of performances by outstanding national and international artists. A chapter newsletter, CIPHERS, is published monthly. Monthly meetings are held in various organ-equipped locations in central Indiana. These meetings consist of a short business session, a concert by a member or a visiting artist, "open console" where members and guests are welcome to play the organ, plenty of refreshments and opportunity to socialize. The American Theatre Organ Society is chartered in California, having been founded there in 1955. It now comprises more than 4,000 members in 60 chapters throughout the world. ATOS publishes a bi-monthly journal, *Theatre Organ*, and stages five-day annual conventions in early summer and occasional three-day regional conventions in the fall.

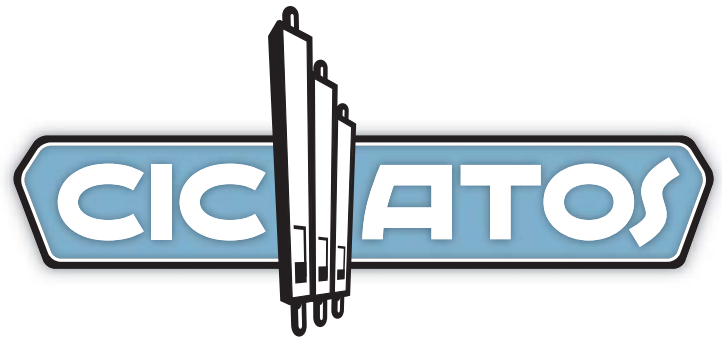
