

VETERAN SERVICE DOGS ORGANIZATION

Due to the success of the golf outing held in September, a donation of \$5K was made by the Detachment to support the Veteran Service Dogs Organization. The VSDO is an all-volunteer-staffed nonprofit organization in Howell, MI that provides a service dog and their training at no cost to a Veteran in need. Dogs are trained to assist Veterans with disabilities such as PTSD, seizures, physical disabilities and more.

With the training, the Veteran is involved in every step of the process; the Vet and the dog work together as a team. The dog's tasks are individually suited to the specific needs of each Veteran along with basic obedience commands. Service dogs are uniquely chosen from local animal shelters; typically rescues who have been saved from unfortunate situations such as homelessness or abusive households. Find out more at vsdo.us
