DEFENDANTS' MOTION TO QUASH SERVICE OF PROCESS

Defendant John Garza t/a Olde Town Parking, by their undersigned attorney, moves pursuant to Maryland Rule 2-121(a) for an order to quash Plaintiffs' Summons and for cause states as follows:

1. On or about April 16, 2015 Plaintiff filed its initial complaint.
