Background: The Music Students' Service League (MSSL) was formed so that students of MTAC members may have the opportunity to serve the community through music. Students share their gift of music with the community by giving recitals in senior citizen living facilities. MSSL is a student-run organization under the guidance of an MTAC teacher.

### **OCTOBER GENERAL MEETING & PROGRAM NOTES**

### MARC LOMBARDINO

Our October Meeting was held at 10am on Friday, 10/6/2017 at the home of Maureen Lombardino. Our topic was a roundtable discussion on Music History and Theory, and how it affects our pedagogy. We had about nine teachers present, and a fruitful discussion followed.

I initiated a discussion of how we incorporate history into our teaching, and those present explained a number of methods they use. These include watching videos of recreated dance genres (for example, the minuet, mazurka, or the waltz), giving biographical information of the composer, discussing period instruments, and so forth. Dr. Louise Earhart then gave a presentation on how her research in Music Theory (starting with her doctoral dissertation on 18th century French music theory) has influenced her personal pedagogy. This includes a unique approach to sight-reading and theory instruction, wherein all elements of notation are broken down into their "basic DNA." For example, differentiating notes on the page not by training to recognize note names and the exact names of notes, but starting with the placement (line and space) and color (white or black) of the note.
