Please remember, Exhibit Entry Forms are due no later than July 21st. Entry forms that are mailed must have a post-mark of July 21st. ***Please do not leave your Entry Forms at the Drop-off Locations, they must go to the Trinity County Fair Office.***

Good news! The decision by the Trinity County Fair Board in February to not allow Independent Livestock exhibitors was reversed at the April Fair Board meeting. A new Independent's Rules and Regulations packet has been developed and is ready for pickup at the Fair Office. *So all you Independent Livestock exhibitors please get your packets immediately!* The date to register for Beef entry has already passed; however, the date for Sheep, Goats and Swine registration is June 9th. The date for Rabbits and Poultry is July 10th. All registration information as defined in the new Independents Exhibitor Packet must be provided to the Fair Office by the dates mentioned above.

Teresa Newman of Hayfork has agreed to be this year's Independent Exhibitor's Advisor. Contact information will be provided to those Independent Exhibitors who pick up their packet at the Fair Office.
