Prayer of the Day Heavenly Father, In this Lenten season, help us to reflect on the mission of your Son. Give us sorrow for our sin, and greater resolve to live for you. Forgive us for being law breakers and grant us the presence of the Holy Spirit. We give all praise and glory to the Son, and we ask this in His name, Amen.

First Lesson Proverbs 3:1-12 **1** My son, do not forget my law, But let your heart keep my commands;**2** For length of days and long life And peace they will add to you.**3** Let not mercy and truth forsake you; Bind them around your neck, Write them on the tablet of your heart,**4** And so find favor and high esteem In the sight of God and man.**5** Trust in the Lord with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding;**6** In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths.**7** Do not be wise in your own eyes; Fear the Lord and depart from evil.**8** It will be health to your flesh, And strength to your bones.**9** Honor the Lord with your possessions, And with the firstfruits of all your increase;**10** So your barns will be filled with plenty, And your vats will overflow with new wine.**11** My son, do not despise the chastening of the Lord, Nor detest His correction;**12** For whom the Lord loves He corrects, Just as a father the son in whom he delights.

Second Lesson Hebrews 13:1-9 **1** Let brotherly love continue.**2** Do not forget to entertain strangers, for by so doing some have unwittingly entertained angels.**3** Remember the prisoners as if chained with them--those who are mistreated--since you yourselves are in the body also.**4** Marriage is honorable among all, and the bed undefiled; but fornicators and adulterers God will judge.**5** Let your conduct be without covetousness; be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you."**6** So we may boldly say: "The Lord is my helper; I will not fear. What can man do to me?"**7** Remember those who rule over you, who have spoken the word of God to you, whose faith follow, considering the outcome of their conduct.**8** Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.**9** Do not be carried about with various and strange doctrines. For it is good that the heart be established by grace, not with foods which have not profited those who have been occupied with them.

Gospel Mark 11:12-19 **12** Now the next day, when they had come out from Bethany, He was hungry.**13** And seeing from afar a fig tree having leaves, He went to see if perhaps He would find something on it. When He came to it, He found nothing but leaves, for it was not the season for figs.**14** In response Jesus said to it, "Let no one eat fruit from you ever again." And His disciples heard it.**15** So they came to Jerusalem. Then Jesus went into the temple and began to drive out those who bought and sold in the temple, and overturned the tables of the money changers and the seats of those who sold doves.**16** And He would not allow anyone to carry wares through the temple.**17** Then He taught, saying to them, "Is it not written, 'My house shall be called a house of prayer for all nations'? But you have made it a 'den of thieves.'" **18** And the scribes and chief priests heard it and sought how they might destroy Him; for they feared Him, because all the people were astonished at His teaching.**19** When evening had come, He went out of the city.
