

### **Above the Ceiling**

Jumping to conclusions has been a recent conversation in my life. This can be detrimental in both the personal and professional fields. One quick example of this is a leak that I have been chasing for almost three weeks now. Since taking over our main building in 2010 we have experienced water flow in our front lot after every heavy rain or over irrigate. I have attributed this to the landscape being of higher elevation than the concrete so it just made sense. In this instance the conclusion jumped to was correct.

However, after a rain event, the flow of water started as expected, but didn't stop after a few days as it typically would. The normal trouble shooting of rechecking the irrigation lines gave us no reduction in flow, so we continue checking all lines and finally found the problem 15 feet downhill from where the symptoms appeared. Not only did I incorrectly assume that the water flowing on top of the concrete was from the rain, but I also assumed that the leak would be above or at least in line with the flow of water. In this field you never know what you're going to find, and occasionally when you do find them you still aren't sure of what you're looking at. Head scratchers are a source of joy for me though and a big reason I have been in the field for as long as I have. From this I have relearned to remain vigilant, and to methodically diagnose issues as they come up. It's too easy to simply adjust the temperature up in an office when the cold complaint comes out, but what if the actuator linkage broke and that's why it's so cold. Never assume, it's an easy fix!

Hopefully you aren't jumping to the conclusion that the SAABE June meeting will be in its normal space at Embassy suites. For June the membership meeting is held at the picnic which is located this year at Castroville Regional Park. Don't let the little bit of a drive put you off though. We are actually closer to central San Antonio than last year, with more space, more activities, but keeping the same great BBQ and comradery. I hope to see you there!

### The Education Corner

Drones may well be the next tool used by Engineers, Management and Owners for due diligence and for "conditional evidence" in Property Matters and Litigation...

The advancement in this area of air crafts yes, air crafts according to the FAA and its approach taken has been all but neglected except by the novice, hobbyists, professionals and the interested. In a nut shell you better have an electronic log of your flights and I'm not talking 'notes'. If your 'craft' does not have this 'digital' ability you're less likely required to get your 'tail-number' from mandatory registration of your craft with the FAA. The fines can be steep for not following the FAA rules when flying, even when you can't believe it's happening to you with your new toy, remember it may be now YOUR air craft.

Rule of thumb, if your craft weighs more than two sticks of butter, you should register it with the current FAA Rules. Less than that, have fun but sustained flight with the craft will be next to mission imposable. If the now "air craft" you just bought is over that weight and can't keep flight routes, altitude, speed, 4K video/Stills—streaming with direct connection of up to at least 14 GPS satellites and do tons of other really fancy things—don't buy it, rent it.

Owning an array of RC crafts both air and ground over the years and even back when they had guild wires to fly them in circles THIS is the best thing yet! I could not believe the technology built in to these little machines. Just the automation programing is unbelievable. Most overhead videos seen on TV and movies are now shot with them—much cheaper than a helicopter with pilot.

Did you know that more than likely you will have to provide the GUI, like your phone or tablet of your choice—and install the app for the controller/camera function and, oh and storage memory should also a consideration on your chosen device.. With this the files are Fat at 4K.... But heck with all us engineers all it takes is curiosity to make the leap, that's what we do when we need to figure things out while expanding our knowledge.

Now having over a million feet of flight logs over the last few months with my hobby craft I would be happy to share or answer questions about what I have learned as a Drone Hobbyist. Most importantly how to use the camera as well as how to air travel with it, out of country travels and related tips one should know to avoid unneeded situations or unexpected costs. Transportation and Aviation information is all about FAA regulations regarding carrying or storing batteries on different flights and destination rules. Be careful not to enter a country/place, which might not allow Drone use unless you pay the bounty, sometimes half the cost of air craft, and fees for every flight. (Flight Log!)
