What is the Orff Approach?

The Orff approach is a way of teaching music to all children through doing, exploring, and improvising. It combines elements of speech, rhythm, movement, song, and dance to teach musical elements and provide children with tools to improvise and create. Teaching with the Orff approach provides multiple entry points and endless opportunities for differentiated instruction, creating a place for every child to grow as a musician.

Benefits of Level I:

- Learn to teach music concepts using speech, body percussion, movement, and song
- The role of the instruments: how to integrate recorder and pitched and non-pitched percussion
- Orchestrations: how to teach orchestrations and how to create your own

Benefits of Level II:

- Build upon the understanding of the Orff media (speech, body percussion, movement, song, and improvisation) and use the media in an active and integrated way
- Explore a variety of sources (literature, poetry) as a starting point for creating music
- Explore the historical context of Orff Schulwerk- Who, What, Where, When, and Why?
- Introduction to alto recorder
- Orchestrations: how to orchestrate melodies with I-V, I-IV, and I-IV-V harmonic accompaniment

Benefits of Level III:

Marcelline Moody will be the Basic Orff Instructor for Level III this year! Don't miss this wonderful opportunity to learn under her guidance!

- Develop mastery of integrating all of the Orff media and teaching strategies of the Orff approach.
- Introduction to the recorder ensemble (SATB)
- Experience and develop understanding of modal music
- Orchestrations: how to compose and orchestrate modal melodies
