John Joseph Murray, 70, died Thursday, March 23, 2000, at Mount Clemens General Hospital. He was born Oct. 19, 1929, in Bad Axe. Mr. Murray was a former assistant Macomb County Prosecuting Attorney and retired as Chief Assistant Attorney in Warren after 19 years of service. Mr. Murray was also a former real estate broker and former student pilot. He was a candidate for Michigan Court of Appeals judge in 1980. Mr. Murray served as a Judge Advocate General officer in the U.S. Army from 1954 to 1957. He was a graduate of the University of Detroit Law School in 1953. Mr. Murray was a resident of Clinton Township. He was a former resident of Port Richie, Fla. His wife, Estelle G. Murray, survives him. He is also survived by four sons, John J.
