Message from Father Tim & The Pastoral Council

Greetings to all our parishioners and hope this message finds you well – as we are now at the halfway point of 2024!

We wanted to share with you a few things that our council has been working on and we will also be looking for your feedback, guidance, and assistance.

1. We have successfully completed a year of the Parishioner and Friends luncheons – these seem to be a hit and we will continue with these luncheons when dates are available. If you have not attended, please consider attending and bringing a friend! This a great opportunity to show off our little parish and socialize – no programs to interfere with conversations and catching up with friends! If you are a parishioner that has a hard time getting to St. Stephen - reach out and we can see how we can get you to the church.

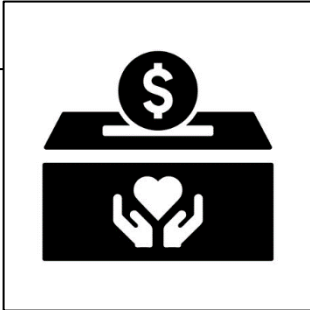
