A WARM WELCOME FOR ALL

Welcome to the Willette church of Christ, where you will find the Bible as our only rule for faith and practice. We seek to speak where the Bible speaks and to be silent where the Bible is silent. We want to call Bible things by Bible names and do Bible things in Bible ways.

Jesus said, "Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost" (Matthew 28:18-20). Our evangelistic efforts include several local and foreign mission works listed on the back of this bulletin. The home congregation is the most important work. Therefore, every month, we spend time door knocking, visiting, and helping our local community. We have a large benevolent building that operates every Tuesday from 8:30-12:30, which offers free clothes and other items to anyone in need. Our primary foreign work is found in Andhra Pradesh, India, where Brother *Jack Honeycutt* serves as our full time mission coordinator. We are also blessed to have a full time prison ministry with services conducted each Sunday from 1:00-3:00. Brother *Tim McHenry* is our regular preacher. In addition to preaching, he teaches classes, works with youth events and community outreach. Our associate preacher *Mark West*, preaches, teaches classes, ministers in the nursing home, coordinates our visitation teams, and work with our Bible camp and youth in general. In addition, we have a radio program on 102.1 FM that airs each weekday around 12:15. If anyone has special needs our Christian Counselor, Dale Sadler, is ready to help by calling 615-513-3642

We are a Bible centered, mission minded, and family oriented church. Thank you for coming, and please return at every opportunity.

I Believe in Prayer (cont.)

We need to learn of THE HINDRANCES TO PRAYER. There are times when we hinder the great opportunities we have through prayer. We do so in a number of ways. For instance, we lack confidence in our prayers. Hebrews 11:6 states, "But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder to them that diligently seek him." When we pray, we must believe confidently that God will answer that prayer in His own way according to His will. We must have faith or not pray. We hinder prayer when we pray amiss. James 4:3 states, "Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts." We cannot pray beyond the will of God and expect God to answer that prayer in the way we want it answered. We hinder prayer when we are not persistent. "Pray without ceasing" was Paul's admonition (I Thess. 5:17). "Continue in prayer, and watch in the same with thanksgiving" (Col. 4:2). And again, the Bible teaches, "Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation, for the spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak" (Mt. 26:41). Don't neglect to pray. Sin hinders prayer. Perhaps, this is the most frequent hindrance that we have. "He that turneth away his ear from hearing the law, even his prayer shall be abomination" (Prov. 28:9). God will not listen to our prayers when we do not listen to His word. If you will not regard God's requests, He will not regard yours. God always answers prayers of faith--the prayers of His believing children. Sometimes, He will say, "Yes," sometimes He will answer, "No," or it may be, "Wait awhile." Whatever the answer may be, God knows what is best. That's why I believe in prayer.
