



Camp Perkins Lodging and Sleeping Spaces Overview

Retreat Center (10 Rooms)

- Rooms 1-8 and Room 10: 1 queen, 1 bunk bed (top and bottom), and 1 twin bed. Each room sleeps 5.
- Room 9 is a “suite” style room and has 1 queen, 1 set of bunks, and a twin sleeper sofa in the main room. It also has a separate smaller bedroom with a second set of bunks. Sleeps 7.
- Rooms 1-9 are on the second floor; Room 10 is on the ground floor - handicap accessible.
- Rooms have a sink in the main room and a separate bathroom with shower and toilet. Rooms 1-9 have a stand-up shower; Room 10 has a bathtub/shower (handicap accessible).
- Rooms are equipped with a nightstand, lamp, alarm clock, power outlets, hooks for hanging clothes/jackets, and hand soap at the sink.
- Towels and bedding are provided in the Retreat Center (unless otherwise arranged).
- Minimum guest count to reserve entire RC at regular charge is 30 people.

Cabins (7 to 11 cabins)

- Cabin guests will use shower houses and provide their own bedding and towels.
- Cabins are equipped with wood stove and wood, shelves, and power outlets.
- There are between 7 and 11 cabins available to rent depending on the season.
- Each cabin has 4 sets of adjustable bunks and 2 single beds. Bunks can be set 3 tiers high (12 sleeping spaces) or 2 tiers high (8 sleeping spaces). Using the beds 2 high is more comfortable for adults but can be used 3 high if desired, especially for children.
- Minimum cabin use at regular charge is an average of 10 people per cabin.
- NOTE: Shower houses are closed down for winter around mid-October.

Housing Policy

Camp Perkins prices for a minimum of 3 people per room in the Retreat Center and 10 people per cabin. Housing fewer people per space might incur additional charges. For example, for a group of 25 people in cabins, you would be assigned 3 cabins at regular charge.
