

SNYDER NAMED MMH CNO

Muenster native Kerri Snyder has been named the new Chief Nursing Officer for Muenster Hospital District, according to MMH CEO Brian Roland.

The selection was announced June 9. Snyder has been serving as Interim CNO since the resignation of Todd Gilbert April 3. She has been with the District since May 2015.

“Kerri brings a unique combination of skills to the job as the permanent Chief Nursing Officer,” Roland stated. “Her ability to understand the electronic health record, her nursing background and her understanding of compliance and regulations is a valuable complement to current leadership.”



Snyder began her nursing education at Cooke County College (now North Central Texas College) where she earned an Associate degree in Nursing in 1991. She received her Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing in 2001 from Midwestern State University and in 2018 she obtained her Master of Science in Nursing Administration from the University of Texas at Arlington.

Her nursing experience is broad and includes time at Texoma Medical Center and Gainesville Memorial/North Texas Medical Center. At NTMC, Snyder served as Director of the Medical and Surgical Units for 7 years, before transferring to a position as Clinical Support Application Analyst (Informatics). She worked in IT for nearly 4 years before coming to Muenster Memorial as the Electronic Health Record and Trauma Program Manager. In September 2016, she was named Chief Clinical Officer.

In her role as CCO, Snyder manages all activities connected to the hospital’s electronic health record, as well as oversees clinical ancillary managers in laboratory, pharmacy and radiology, policy management and disaster preparedness. These duties will be integrated with her management of the nursing staff.

Snyder is a Healthcare Accreditation Certified Professional (HACP) by the Center for Improvement in Healthcare Quality.

Recently, Snyder was named by Becker’s Hospital Review as one of the 50+ Top CNOs to Know in 2020. Becker’s is a top trade publication for the healthcare industry. Snyder was listed alongside the CNOs of some of the largest and most respected healthcare systems in the nation.
