Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

To enter online, go to the AKC Agility Online Entry Services home page at <u>www.akc.org/AgilityEntry</u>. Follow the instructions there to use your "My AKC" account to enter this event online. For the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries is designated as follows: 350 online entries, 350 paper entries. After the first 48 hours, if either form of entry (online or paper) has not filled, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly.

ENTRIES: ONLINE VS PAPER, Maximum entries per envelope

- Paper entries received within 24 hrs. of the opening date & time must include postage or be metered. Paper entries must be
 delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including, but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If the
 above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.
- A maximum of 10 entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than 10 entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to any dog fifteen (15) months of age or older that is registered with the AKC or that has AKC Limited Registration, PAL/ILP, or an AKC Canine Partners listing number with the exception of bitches in season, blind dogs, aggressive dogs or those suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

CHECK YOUR ENTRY FORMS AND CONFIRMATIONS

Please be aware that AKC rules prohibit modification of an entry after the closing date/time except for move-ups as outlined on the next page and moves as covered in Chapter 1, Section 21 of the Regulations for Agility Trials. The trial secretary is not allowed to change jump heights or change a dog from preferred to regular or vice versa or move a dog down in class after closing of the trial.

A preliminary email confirmation will be sent when the entry is received and processed. Make sure to check those confirmations closely and notify the trial secretary if you have corrections or changes before the closing date, or as outlined in the regulations.

OBSTACLES AND RINGS

All obstacles shall meet the specifications as outlined in the current edition of Regulations for Agility Trials. These agility trials will be held indoors on dirt surface with ring sizes of 90' deep x 100' wide. <u>Judging shall begin no earlier than 8:00 a.m. on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.</u> Times may be later depending on the number of entries received.

ALL DAYS: There will be no Novice equipment familiarization at these trials.

CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter the dog in the correct class. If this is your first entry in the Preferred class you must start in the Novice class. Exemption: If your dog has been running in regular classes and you have not yet used your one-time lateral transfer option, the dog may be entered in the same level as it runs in the regular classes but must jump 4" lower. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390, or from the AKC website at http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/REAGIL.pdf.

Height Divisions

All dogs without a height card (permanent or valid temporary yellow sheet) must be measured by the judge before running. On Saturday and Sunday, measuring will begin ½ hour before the start of runs for the day. If the measurement of your dog at the trial puts your dog into a different jump height than entered in, you must notify the Trial Secretary immediately.

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - o Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.



Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

HEIGHT CARD REGULATIONS

Jump height cards are <u>not required to be submitted with the entry form</u>. The entry form has a check box to indicate if the dog needs to be measured. It is the owner's responsibility to understand the rules, and if the dog needs to be measured, it is the owner's/handler's responsibility to ensure that the box on the entry form is checked, and that the dog is measured prior to running. If you are unsure, contact the trial secretary for assistance.

PRIZES AND AWARDS

Qualifying score required for all prizes. All ribbons are flat ribbons. Qualifying score – Dark Green First Prize – Blue N Second Prize – Red ar Third Prize – Yellow sc Fourth Prize – White

New Title Ribbons and Double Q ribbons are available for any dog completing a title at this trial or receiving a qualifying score in both the Mas STD and Mas JWW class.

High in Trial ribbons for each group awarded for Friday and Saturday – Highest score and YPS in Standard and Jumpers. High in Trial ribbon for small (4-16") & tall (20-24") dogs in Premier – Highest score and YPS in Premier STD & JWW.

Please notify the Trial Chair or Trial Secretary if you are close to completing a MACH/PACH title at this trial.

MOVE-UPS – CHECK-IN

Deadline for move-ups for these trials is Monday, February 3rd, 2020 at 6 p.m. PST. Move-ups must be submitted in writing (e-mail okay). Move-ups are not official until e-mail confirmation of the move-up has been received by the participant. Friday to Saturday and Saturday to Sunday move-ups will be allowed.

JUDGING SCHEDULE

JUDGING WILL BEGIN NO EARLIER THAN 8:00 A.M. ON EACH TRIAL DAY.

PREMIER CLASS INFORMATION: Any dog, regardless of level, may be run in the Premier classes.

REFUNDS: A complete refund will be given, for any reason, if withdrawal notice is received <u>before</u> the closing date and time. After closing, a refund of entry fees, less \$10/day, will be given for any bitch that comes into season provided notification with documentation is received at least 30 minutes before the start of the trial. A refund of <u>one-half</u> the entry fees will be given for dogs that are injured, provided a veterinary certificate is provided AND notification is received by the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes before the dog is scheduled to run in its first run of the weekend. No other refunds will be given after closing. No refunds will be given for amounts less than \$10.

VENDORS

TRIAL REGULATIONS & NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The Trial will be open from 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. all days. Consult final confirmation for order of classes and times of judging.
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone, faxed, or telegraphed entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms and/or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement and rules that accompany the Official AKC entry form are not acceptable.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. Post dated checks do not constitute a valid entry. Checks will be deposited
 immediately after the trial closes.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Entry fees will NOT be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge during the trial, or barred from competition by the Show Committee.
- OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or child(ren) create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- Sorry, no puppies under 3 months of age are allowed in the trial arena. Aggressive dogs will not be allowed.
- The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Head halters, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited on trial grounds. Body harnesses are OK.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm up area. The leash may
 have a single pick-up bag and/or identification tag attached to it. Painted or stitched designs or information on collars can be only
 the dog's name and/or identifying information.
- The Mt. Rainier Sporting Spaniel Association, Argus Ranch Facility for Dogs, and Marian Snapp, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardian.
- PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG(S). Failure to do so will be considered a benchable offense and we want to use this facility in the future.
- This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
