Spiritual Growth Corner

As I write this, we have just celebrated The Feasts of Pentecost and the Most Holy Trinity. Both of these celebrate the Holy Spirit.

The first reminds us of the fulfillment of the promise Jesus made to the Apostles, and all of us, that He would send us a Helper, that even though He was leaving, He was not going to abandon us. He kept that promise when He sent the Holy Spirit to the Apostles in that upper room appearing as tongues of fire. He sends the Spirit to all the rest of us in the Sacrament of Baptism.

Just as the Apostles received special gifts from God through the Holy Spirit, we receive special gifts when we are baptized. These gifts are strengthened in us through the graces received in the sacrament of Confirmation. Our job is to discern what our special gift is and how we are supposed to use it to further the Kingdom of God. If you haven't done so yet, it isn't too late. One of the worst things we can hear at our first meeting with Jesus after we pass from this world is, "Why didn't you use the gifts I sent you to bring more people to me?"

The second Feast is a reminder to us that the Holy Spirit is God, part of the Holy Trinity. I think sometimes we forget about the Holy Spirit being the one Jesus sent to help us. We don't turn to Him often enough for the help we need. It is easy to say we have a relationship with God the Father or Jesus but not so easy for the Holy Spirit. We need to develop that relationship no matter how difficult. After all, Jesus sent Him to help us, and I think He knows what is best for us.

These are followed by the Feast of The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi), another reminder from the Church for us of one of our most significant beliefs. As you approach the altar each Sunday to receive Communion, do you reflect on who it is you are about to receive? Do you reflect on the fact that Jesus loves each of us so much that He didn't want to leave us, so He comes to us physically at each Mass when the host is consecrated and to each of us individually when we receive Him in the Eucharist? That is certainly something to think and pray about.

Please remember to join us at St. Vincent on July 7 at 7:00 PM for our 411th Rosary for the sick. What a blessing it is that we have the freedom to meet and share in this special time.
