**Workshop Description:**

Roberta explains, "Instead of using brushes to apply color, diluted watercolors are poured from small containers over the surface of the paper to create beautiful blends of colors. Shapes are defined by blocking them out with maskit in various stages of the pouring. Values will be built up in a layering process. The colors of each poured layer becomes more intense and concentrated than the one preceding it."
