

MANITOBA HUMAN TRAFFICKING AWARENESS DAY PRAYER INITIATIVE - HISTORY

According to the legislated act, Manitoba Human Trafficking Awareness Day is on the **Thursday of the second full week** in March. It is a time to reflect and become more aware of human trafficking within Manitoba.

2020 is the 6th year Inner City Women's Ministries International, a ministry which started in Niverville and Winnipeg due to local human trafficking situations, is coordinating prayer gatherings across the Province of Manitoba.

The mission of Inner City Women's Ministries International is to support women and their families in spiritual and tangible ways. The Manitoba sector has been led to walk alongside women struggling with addictions and/or incarceration as well as survivors of exploitation (human trafficking). Many times addictions, incarceration and exploitation go hand in hand.

The trafficking of persons for labour and/or sex is big business world wide including Manitoba. Presently there are over 5000 men, women and children missing within Manitoba and according to the RCMP there is a direct correlation between missing persons and human trafficking.

ICWMI staff (all unpaid volunteers) have walked alongside female survivors of human trafficking within Manitoba since 2003 and is indebted to its many partners, supporters, prayer warriors and God, through Jesus Christ.

How Can You Participate In The 6th Annual Manitoba Human Trafficking Awareness Day Prayer Initiative?

1. Bring together people you know and PRAY IN YOUR HOME, PLACE OF WORK, SCHOOL, BAND OFFICE, FAITH INSTITUTION for God to bring home our missing loved ones, friends, fellow Manitobans. 7:30 in the morning Thursday, March 12th, 2020. (Prayer point suggestions follow this page)
2. INVITE YOUR LOCAL GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS to your prayer gathering.
3. TELL LOCAL MEDIA AND PUT OUT ON SOCIAL MEDIA about your plans to pray back the over 5000 missing persons from Manitoba on Manitoba Human Trafficking Awareness Day Thursday, March 12th, 2020.
4. INFORM STAFF AT INNER CITY WOMEN'S MINISTRIES INTERNATIONAL that you will be praying at 7:30 am Thursday, March 12th, 2020 in order that we may pray for you and keep track of which areas in Manitoba are covered and/or still need prayer covering.

Why 7:30 in the morning? Christ sacrificed for us, our missing loved ones may be suffering - can we make a small sacrifice for them?
