Mayor Russell Wood, Jr. called to order the Village of Bloomingburg Regular Board of Trustees Meeting on July 11th, 2019 at 6:00pm in the Village of Bloomingburg Hall, Bloomingburg, N.Y.

The meeting was open with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Regular Meeting

Mayor Wood asked the Board if they had a chance to review the minutes from June.

Trustee Samuel Weingarten agreed he has as well as Trustee Aaron Rabiner.

Mayor Wood asks for a motion to approve the minutes from June. Aaron Rabiner makes the motion and is seconded by Samuel Weingarten.

Mayor Wood asks if the Board has had a chance to review the monthly bills from June. Mayor Wood asked for a motion to approve the bills, Samuel Weingarten makes the motion and is seconded by Aaron Rabiner.

Mayor Wood: We held open a Public Hearing last month for local law #5 of 2019 for Amendment to the Garbage Law. We have Aaron here tonight, we wanted to wait to vote on it last month because it was Aaron's recommendation to amend the current local law. The amendment allows for residents to have a storage container at the end of their driveways to store their garbage cans. The storage still needs to be 30ft from the road or 15ft at the discretion of the Building Inspector. All storage containers need to be inspected by the Village Building Inspector but there will be no fee. You still need a building permit so the Village can control the structures being built or purchased. The fines will also change. The second offense will be \$75.00 and the third offense not to exceed \$100.00.

Mayor Wood: Can I have a motion to close the Public Hearing.

Aaron Rabiner: I will make it.

Samuel Weingarten: I will second it.

Mayor Wood: Can I have a motion to pass local law # 5 of 2019.

Aaron Rabiner: I will make it.

Samuel Weingarten: I will second the motion.

Mayor Wood: I have a Resolution here for the Village Board of Trustees to do the Annual Audit of the court. Can I have a motion to approve the resolution?

Aaron Rabiner: I will make the motion .

Samuel Weingarten: I will seconded it.

Mayor Wood: We have a resolution here to adopt the Fee Schedule for the Village. We approved this back when I took office years ago but we never officially had a resolution on hand for the vote. The fees are all staying the same, there are no changes. Can I have a motion to adopt this resolution.

Aaron Rabiner: I will make it.

Samuel Weingarten: I will second it.

Mayors Report

Mayor Wood: The roads will milled on Monday and they were paved today. Roads are all smoothed an fixed. They finished up today. Sullivan County will be out after the weather gets a little less hot and rain stops to restripe the yellow and white lines. They were going to come a few weeks ago but we held them off until the roads were redone. The cross walk same thing the guy will be out soon to redo them over here at the light and up by the school. We had a request for 45 River Lane to change from R1 to NBD, before anyone says anything we are not making any more changes. I have a meeting with Village Engineer Tom Depuy to discuss a few things. If we keep granting changes then it changes the Villages comprehensive plan. So we will be holding off on any type of change requests at the moment. Tom is also reworking on the easements that we need. I going to try and get a meeting with the County again after speaking with the school about safety of the children. That's all I have.
