cutting

grey (10)  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares

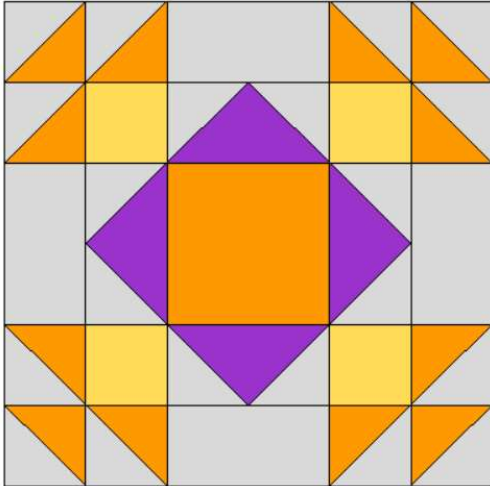
(4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

gold (6)  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares

(1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

yellow (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

purple (1)  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " square

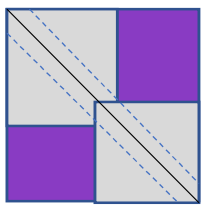


Assembly directions:

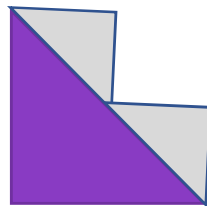
Remember all seams are  $\frac{1}{4}$ ". It is always best practice to test your seams before you assemble blocks. Let's start with the grey  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares and the gold  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Draw one diagonal line on each grey piece. Place (6) grey squares on top of (6) gold squares. Stitch on both sides of the drawn line. Cut on drawn line and press open. They should measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square. You will have 12 half square triangles.

Next, using the remaining  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " grey squares (with the diagonal line drawn on them), place (2) on opposite corners of the  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " purple. Sample 1. Please note that the 2 grey pieces overlap in the center.

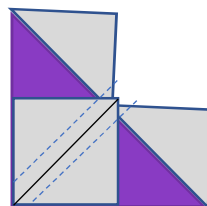
Sew on both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the sewn line and press grey away from purple. Sample 2. Finally, place one grey square on each of the pieces, Sample 3. Sew on both sides of the drawn line and cut apart. Press towards the grey. You now have 4 Flying Geese.

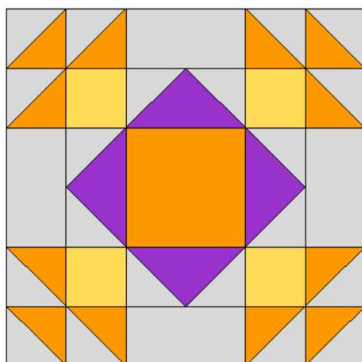
