THINKING AHEAD . . . Next Sunday

PALM SUNDAY (Passion Sunday): The Sunday immediately preceding Easter Sunday. Palm Sunday commemorates the entry of Jesus into Jerusalem and begins the series of observances focusing on the events of Holy Week. This Sunday is also often referred to as Passion Sunday, marking the beginning of the passion or suffering of Jesus leading to and including the crucifixion.

PALMS: The leaves of the palm tree used in many churches as part of the procession and the observances of the Palm Sunday worship services. The palms symbolize the response of the people to the entry of Jesus into Jerusalem at the beginning of Holy Week. They are burned before the following Ash Wednesday, their remains becoming the ashes.
