Pastor's Portion

"You represent the presence of God"

I recently returned from our CB North Central annual meeting which for several years now has partnered with the Moody Pastors Conference in Chicago, IL. This was a great conference and we, the pastors attending, were blessed with great God centered worship and Bible teaching. It was rejuvenating and the quote you read above is just one powerful quote which came out of this conference. That is only part of the quote though. I'd like to share some of his teaching with you. The quote was by a man names Skye Jethani. He shared that he was a hospital chaplain when he was going through seminary, and as a young seminary student, he would often be nervous and not know what to say or do when he would enter a room to visit with a stranger. But then he received the following words of wisdom from a professor, "When you walk up to a room, place your hand on the door frame and silently pray and remember the following statement, "In this room you represent the presence of God". That is a powerful statement and is both a scary and convicting thought, but also a comforting thought. I would love to expand on that, but space does not allow so let's go straight to applying this to our lives and I'll let you think over the quote and thoughts more on your own. Many of us think the world will pay attention to you and the church when we have something of great importance to show them. A better way to marriage, raising kids, a quick way to make money, etc. but what Skye spoke of is that we already have the thing that matters most! The presence of God. Until we enter rooms with that power, and that presence, the culture around us is not going to change. Here was the challenge to us, and I would like to pass it on to you as well. Do you represent the presence of God in every room you go into? Do you see all people as valuable and needing to see and know more about this God with you represent? Do you see all people as valuable, not for what these people can offer or give you, but who God created them to be? Summer is a busy time of year, but I want to challenge you, as I was also challenged, to represent the presence of God WELL wherever this summer leads you, no matter how busy you are, and no matter whose "room" you walk into. People are watching. Are they seeing God in you? Praise God for the opportunity to represent Him.
