

New Policies

There are some new policies that have now come into effect with regards to your shoot and must be complied with. These are to try and keep you and your family as safe as possible.

Unfortunately, It will not be possible to social distance within the studio space. This is why extra precautions have been put into place and we must make you aware of this before you arrive for your shoot. It is with regret that some of these changes do take away from the welcoming/friendly service we are proudly known for. We will try to have the least amount of contact possible with you and your baby and will ask you to place and comfort your baby with our direction.

For newborn sessions, I will ask that parents place the baby, and Lisa or I will position them to achieve the poses. Lisa will remain within 1m of your baby for safety purposes.

Please read the following rules we have had to put in place:

- · Deep cleaning before and after every shoot.
- Hand sanitising station will be provided and need to be used upon entering the studio.
- Photographers will wear aprons and face coverings/shields for the duration of the shoot.
- Clients are asked to wear face coverings for the duration of the shoot however, these may be removed for a family photo.
- Access to the studio via the back gate to the garden. This will be open for you to come through and we will be there to welcome you. There will be a sign that will help show you where to go.
- There will unfortunately be no access to toilet facilities. We apologies for any inconvenience this may cause.
- Shooting times for Newborn's will be reduced to around 2 hours. We will use our expertise to still get the same variety of images but it is important to reduce the amount of time we are in the studio for, especially as we are not able to social distance.
- You are more than welcome to bring along your own drinks and snacks but we do ask that you take your own rubbish away with you. Unfortunately we have had to remove our welcome drink station for the time being.
- Shoes must be removed as you are enter the shooting space and left on the doormat.
- At the moment, based on the guidelines, I will have to restrict the amount of people in the studio at the same time and asking that only one family member stay with baby for the duration of their shoot. I am aware this may be disappointing and we apologise for any inconvenience this may cause. I will still be offering the chance for families to have parent and family photos however, I ask that until we are ready to take that particular shot, that anyone else wait outside until we are ready to take the photo. I know how important it is to include siblings as well but I ask that the guidelines apply to them as well.
