Each year Augustus Lutheran Church seeks your commitment of financial support for the ministries we plan to provide in following calendar year. Your generous commitment is essential to funding our ministries and programs of worship, learning, and serving our neighbors in need at Augustus. Without your support, these ministries cannot happen.

In Jesus' name and with your support:

- Over 40 children enrolled in Sunday School learn about God's love for them,
- 27 young people prepare for First Holy Communion or Confirmation, and
- Several dozen high school students participate in the Senior High Youth Group.

Furthermore,

- We prepare and serve 150 meals each month to our neighbors in need in Norristown, PA.
- We provide hats, gloves, and Christmas gifts for the vulnerable young people at the Silver Springs Martin Lutheran School in Plymouth Meeting.
- We collect non-perishable food products weekly for the Daily Bread Food Pantry, which helps our less well-off neighbors in the Trappe-Collegeville area.
