City Council Minutes

November 4<sup>th</sup>, 2019

The City Council of the City of New Munich met in regular session at 6:30p.m., in the City Hall. Jim Poepping, Shawn Duevel, Pat Nathe, Elmer Boecker and Ron Doll were present.

On a motion by Ron Doll, seconded by Elmer Boecker and carried the from October 7<sup>th</sup>, 2019 were approved.

Fire Chief, Allen Fiedler was present to inform the Council of three medical calls last month. The Fire Relief meeting will be 11/26/19 at 7pm. The fundraiser from last month was a total profit of \$8,828.51.
