July is a month that brings about a great deal of excitement as it marks the official start of summer, providing ample opportunities for outdoor fun in the sun. - Neil Armstrong made history on July 29, 1969, by taking the first steps on the moon. His famous declaration "That's one small step for man, one giant leap for mankind!"
- Famous people born in July include Princess Diana, Tom Hanks, Dan Aykroyd, Edie Falco, Ernest Hemingway, Kevin Bacon, Liv Tyler, Margot Robbie, Nelson Mandela, Pamela Anderson, Ringo Starr, Sylvester Stallone, Tom Cruise, Arnold Schwarzenegger.
- July is recognized as National Watermelon Month, National Ice Cream Month, and National Hot Dog Month, in the United States
