

You will get to see first hand where the SDSU Signature Wool blankets were created ~ from clean wool to finished product! Enjoy refreshments, lunch & fun during the trip.

Friday after the bus tour will feature our special "Night at the Museum". Attendees will enjoy a wide variety of lamb appetizers, assorted goodies, and social time at the SD Agricultural Heritage Museum. The current displays are: "The Unspun Tale: Sheep in SD" and "Barley to Barrel: Science and History of Brewing in SD". The family-friendly social will also feature activities for the younger crowd.

Unique hand-crafted wool items using SDSU Wool Project fabric or yarn will be on display during the social ~ and everyone will have a chance to bid on them during the evening auction. All proceeds from the challenge auction will be donated to the SDSU Signature Wool Project scholarship fund!

Saturday morning our main program will begin at the Days Inn Convention Center. Following our official welcome to Brookings and SDSU, Peter Orwick, ASI, and Dale Thorne, ALB will cover current issues and sheep industry updates. Benny Cox, ALB, will address the effects of changing market demographics on the sheep industry. Lisa Webster, owner of North Star Sheep Farm in Maine will talk about promotion of sheep from farm to table in their operation. The SD Master Lamb Producer Luncheon will highlight the award winning sheep operations for 2017.

The afternoon will feature Dan Persons from Shearwell Data with sheep ID management, followed by Danci Baker speaking on farm transition planning.

The business meeting will also be held in the afternoon, and producers and convention attendees are encouraged to take part. New directors will be elected, issues in the sheep industry addressed, and educational and promotional activities will be planned for the coming year.

We will have an on-going trade show on Saturday, and opportunities for producers to network with others and meet with industry leaders from the region.

Saturday will also feature a "Fleece to Shawl" contest. Teams will be working from 9 am to 5 pm to complete a shawl from SD wool. Each shawl will be auctioned on Saturday night prior to the banquet at the social hour. Area fiber guilds will host fun "hands-on" wool activities for both kids and adults during the morning.

Join us on a "bonus tour" Sunday morning to the Larry & Susan Holler operation just north of Brookings and see a first-hand demonstration of the Shearwell Data system for animal identification & management.
