ZAAP Celebrates 25 years with art from founders and part directors. Featured artists are Bruce and Ophelia Hiestand, who were founding ZAAP members, loved to paint and draw. Bruce mostly worked in 3-d wooden folk art pieces and Opie painted scenes from her life. Both enjoyed creating art of all kinds from landscapes to abstracts. Both were self-taught and Bruce learned from drawing out of comic books as a child. They lived life as spontaneous as a couple could and conveyed that spirit into their creations.

Bruce Hiestand was born May 28, 1933, in Newark, a son of the late Harry and Hilda Bowman Hiestand. He graduated with the New Concord High School Class of 1951 and then graduated from the Cleveland School of Welding in 1953. Bruce previously owned Tiki Sign Co. in Kaneoheo, Hawaii, and served as a missionary for two years in Texas, where he met his future wife. He then went on to become a union carpenter in Los Angeles, Calif. then working in Carpenters Union 267 in Dresden. Bruce was an artist who enjoyed folk art, drawing, and painting and was a member of ZAAP. Ophelia Hernandez Hiestand was born March 17, 1945, in Rio Hondo, Texas, a daughter of the late Librado Villanueva and Juanita Lopez Hernandez. She graduated high school from Rio Hondo High School Class of 1964, attended Durham's Business College in Harlingen, Texas, and Ohio University-Zanesville. She had worked in the personnel department for Bethesda Hospital in Zanesville and as a real estate agent. Ophelia was an artist who enjoyed painting and was a member of ZAAP. We would like to invite anyone who knew them to come to the show and see a glimpse of early ZAAP members.
