Mailbox Update

A BIG THANK YOU to everyone for being so patient and understanding on the installation of our new mailboxes. Here's what we know to date:

• Installation will begin on November 29th for the mailboxes that need new pads. It should take 2-3 days for the concrete to dry. The rest of the mailboxes will be installed after the concrete is poured.

The U.S. Postal Service maintenance staff will be removing all the

existing mailboxes. Express Mailboxes is trying to coordinate with the U.S. Postal Service to remove just the mailboxes that need new pads, but they may remove all of them at one time. If they remove all of them at one time, there will be no mail delivered for seven (7) days for everyone. You will need to pick your mail up at the Via de Ventura Post Office, 8790 E. Via de Ventura, Scottsdale, AZ.

- We will receive all the keys and matching addresses on Saturday, December 4th. We are targeting getting mailbox keys to residents (unless otherwise noted) on Saturday, December 4th and Sunday, December 5th. You will be able to pick up and sign off as receiving your mailbox keys in the pool area. More details are to come.
- If you have made previous arrangements to get your mailbox keys another way, it has been noted and we will follow your instructions.
