FRIENDLY REMINDER: Before planting season begins we'd like to remind residents not to plant crops in the road right-of-way. The right-of-way is most generally 33 feet from the center of any road or highway and any crops planted in the right-of-way would be violation of Minnesota Statute 160.2715. If you have questions, please contact us before you plant.

DUSTCOATING: Residents may sign-up for dust coating at the Town Hall on Wednesday, April 24th from 6pm-8pm and Saturday, April 27th from 8:00am – 11:00am. If you prefer, you may mail a check payable to Marysville Township to the Town Hall; make sure your address and the number of feet to dustcoat are included on your check. Don't forget to mark the area with stakes. The cost will again be \$60 per 100 feet.

BURNING PERMITS: The most convenient way to get a burning permit is to go online to https://webapps8.dnr.state.mn.us/burning_permits/, create an account and activate the permit when you want to burn. Any restrictions are noted on the permit. There is an annual fee of \$5.00 and it's so convenient! RECYCLING:

The pounds per household is calculated by the tons collected for the quarter, divided by 3 months and then divided by the current number of households which is currently 880 households. We have an average 436 households that recycle. The more you can recycle and can encourage your neighbor the better our program becomes.

We do have additional bins available for recycling, please call the Town Hall and let us know you need an additional bin.

In 2018 Marysville Township Recycling totals are as follows:

Quarter 1 – Collected 31.97 pounds per household per month.

Quarter 2 – Collected 28.15 pounds per household per month.

Quarter 3 – Collected 31.58 pounds per household per month.

Quarter 4 – Collected 27.42 pounds per household per month.

Wright County's goal for Townships is to collect 35 pounds per household per month.

Recycling calendars were mailed in February 2019.

Recycling is picked up curbside starting at 7am. Everything can be mixed together in the Mumford Sanitation recycling bins. If you have questions about pick-up, please call Mumford Sanitation at 320-543-3601.

Recycling is taken to the McLeod County recycling center, where it is sorted and distributed. The more we recycle the better for the environment and it can even reduce your garbage bill.

This meeting was conducted by an appointed moderator, Fred Bonk, and the Board was there to provide information and listen to residents' concerns. Jane Hurley was re-elected for Supervisor on a 3-year term with 33 votes. The Townships financial status, road maintenance and operating needs for the future were topics of discussion. These issues can directly affect the levy amount for the following year.
