

Millard "Bill" Deering, age 91 of Bad Axe, passed away on Monday, July 16, 2018, at Courtney Manor Nursing Facility of Bad Axe after a short illness.

Bill was born in Elkton on October 19, 1926, son of the late Jacob and Katherine (Frank) Deering, Sr. He attended Elkton High School, graduating in 1945. On August 19, 1950, he married Beatrice Buchholz at Cross Lutheran Church in Pigeon.

After serving in the U.S. Army during WWII, Bill attended Deforest training in Chicago where he earned a degree in radio & TV repair.
