After a successful military career, Campbell served four terms as a Congressman in the United States House of Representatives for Pennsylvania's 17th congressional district. Campbell was a charter member and the first Noble Grand of Alma Lodge #523 and also served as Grand Master of the Grand Lodge of Pennsylvania.
