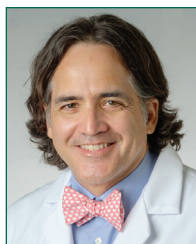


L. Raúl Arroyo, M.D.

After earning his B.A. from The Johns Hopkins University in Maryland, Dr. Arroyo earned his medical degree from the University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine in Philadelphia, PA. He went on to complete his Residency in General Surgery at Pennsylvania Hospital and to complete a Microsurgery Research Fellowship in the Department of Plastic Surgery at the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania in 1994. He was the Chief Resident in General Surgery at Pennsylvania Hospital in Philadelphia from 1995-1996.

Dr. Arroyo has been in practice for 20 years. He served as the Medical Director of the Jupiter Medical Center Breast Cancer Liaison Program, and, in addition, served as the Interim Medical Director of the Comprehensive Breast Health Program. He was
