Trip Highlights:

Memphis to New Orleans: The Paddlewheel Cruise on October 30th is sold out. Anyone interested in going on this trip can be wait listed at this time. We have 28 people that have signed up. Many people are spending time in Nashville ahead of the cruise to go to the Grand Old Opry. After the cruise people are spending two or three days in New Orleans.



2017 Big Sky Ski Trip: February 7th-14th-Contracts are signed and I will be sending out the signup information sometime next week. People have the option of staying in The Huntley Hotel or in the Summit. The Summit has Kings, Queens and Condo's available. Our trip includes breakfast every day and a 5 out of 7-day ski pass.

We will be transferred by bus from the Bozeman Airport to Big Sky. The trip is 42 miles.



Cruises for 2017: The following cruises have been set up. For more information, pricing or to sign up please call Grace Van Brunt at 843-341-8911.

March 7th- 14th on Holland America's ship the Zaandam from Santiago, Chile to Buenos Aires, Argentina- This cruise has several promotions that are available. Holland America has a 30th anniversary promotion that expires on May 15th. The deposit to sign up is only \$200.00 per person. Room gratuities are included as well as a \$50.00 package per person. We will be putting together options for tours before and after this cruise.

Papeete Tahiti on the Wind Spirit a 4-masted sailing ship from August $14^{th} - 25^{th}$ -This ship accommodates 148 people and will be sailing among the Society and Tuamotu Islands. Currently there is reduced pricing for this sailing. We are awaiting additional promotions before signing up. Last year there was special airfare pricing.

Montreal to Fort Lauderdale on Holland America's ship the Veendam from October 7th-20th. We have group pricing at this time for this cruise.
