Administrative Action

Closed Session Report

The Board reconvened in open session at 3:30 p.m. and Chairman Mello announced the board took no reportable action, but did direct staff to send a letter to DWR demanding DWR maintain water quality per the 1981 Contract.

Public Comment

No public comments provided.

Announcements

Due to exceedances of the salinity criteria at the Three Mile Slough monitoring location that is specified in the 1981 Contract, Melinda recommended scheduling another Special Board Meeting on October 26th to provide the public an update on drought conditions and water quality, and to present the framework developed for implementation of a Dry-Year Incentive Pilot Program between January through June 2022. Director Mello agreed with having another meeting and pointed out that daily salinity spikes are significantly higher than the 14-day mean criteria in the Contract. Gary announced that CVP has reduced its Delta exports from 1,700 cfs down to 700 cfs and will continue keeping the Delta Cross Channel gates open on the weekend and shut during the week and plan to permanently from December 2021 through May 2022.
