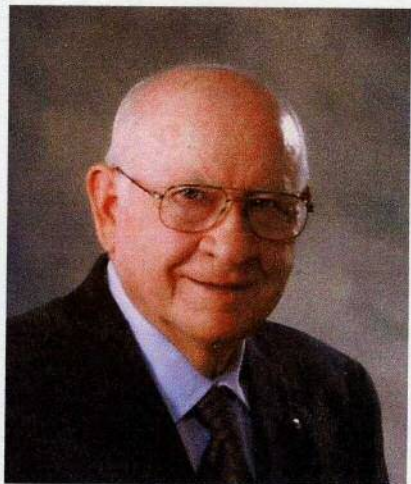


Mr. Thomas Jonah Lundy
