Colonel Will Tyminski U.S. Army Retired will present a series of observations and incidents that occurred in his over 30 years of military experience with the quality lessons entailed by each. This anecdotal recollection will link those experiences to issues with Quality Management Systems, Supply Chain Management and Lean Process Improvement.

About the Speaker:

Colonel (Retired) William B. Tyminski AUS, served for over 30 years in the United States Marine Corps and United States Army. After transitioning to the Army National Guard in 1992 he commanded an Aviation Logistics Maintenance Company and a UH-1 Huey helicopter battalion. From 2007-2008 he served as Deputy Commander of Task Force Lexington, a base defense force of 1800 persons that protected 60,000 inhabitants at the largest coalition base in Iraq. He completed his career as Director, Strategic Plans Policy and International Affairs for the Massachusetts National Guard. In this position he applied business strategy systems to government operations, planned and managed disaster response operations and managed a military partnership program with the Republic of Paraguay. Colonel (Retired) Tyminski holds a Bachelor’s Degree in Economics from the Virginia Military Institute and a Master of Science degree from the University of Massachusetts – Boston. He is currently in search of his next career.
