In the last four years I have provided leadership at the District 5 level and at the city-at-large. At the district level I have had district meetings on Traffic and Youth Violence Prevention. In October I will be having a District meeting on learning about the three Affordable Housing Programs Watsonville has. For city issues I have brought to the Council for discussion or action issues of Human Trafficking, Climate Change, Flavored Tobacco, Predatory Lending, and Reaffirming our Sanctuary Status. Issues that remain to be addressed is Homelessness, Housing Affordability, and Sustaining our Budget with Pension Increases. The issues I address apply to all members of our community including GLBT.

As a Chicana/Latina born and raised in Watsonville I have had to overcome many barriers. obstacles and discrimination. LGBTIQ individuals have also have had to overcome barriers, obstacles, and discrimination. We need to work together to attain social justice for all of us.

Q8 Please tell us about any past or current experiences or involvement you've had addressing LGBTIQ issues or work you've done to support the LGBTIQ community.

My first experience with LGBTIQ issues was when I was Principal of Rolling Hills Middle School in the 1990's. I had a young student who was bullied because she publicly declared she was gay. I had discussions with her to have her hold her head up high and of course gave consequences to those who bullied her. Most recently my only alley on the City Council is Jimmy Dutra. Jimmy has often shared with me the issues with which he has to deal. I support the Pajaro Valley Pride by attending their annual celebration and last year contributed to their scholarship fund.

Q9 What historic political or civil rights struggles are you familiar with that impact LGBTIQ equality?

There are so many, but the one that stands out for me is the struggle to marry the person you love.

Q10 What is your philosophy about working with minority communities of which you are not a member, and how will this manifest in your future work with the LGBTIQ community?

As I previously mentioned social justice has to be fought by all of us together. LBGTIQ is an oppressed group. As a Chicana I've have had to fight that oppression all my life.
