

Young Skeptics Curriculum Development Temporary Internship

General Description

Under the support and supervision of the Curriculum Director and Executive Director, the Curriculum Development Intern will develop curricula for 1-hour Young Skeptics sessions, focused on varying subjects, such as: critical thinking, the scientific method, evidence-based reasoning, and other related topics. Topics will be suggested by Developer and the Board of Directors. This is a 6-week temporary internship position, with opportunity for renewal at its conclusion.

Primary duties and responsibilities:

- Produce detailed curriculum materials for Young Skeptics sessions, including presentation files, activities, and facilitator guides.
- Evaluate existing course materials and improve upon them where possible.
- Identify additional topics for future lessons and propose them to Board of Directors for approval.
- Format deliverables using Young Skeptics templates, style guides, and formatting guidelines.

Computer or other special needs for the position:

Personal computer, MS Word and PowerPoint.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Education (completed or in progress) and experience in one or more of the following fields:
 - Elementary education
 - Science/medicine
 - Childhood development
- Elementary-level teaching experience, particularly teaching sciences
- Experience working with children of various ages, either in a teaching or child care scenario
- Experience writing curriculum and instruction, preferably in the area of elementary education
- Excellent written, oral, and interpersonal communication skills
- Computer literacy
- Strong organizational skills

Note: This is an unpaid temporary internship position. Selected candidates must be available to contribute a minimum of 3-5 hours/week for a period of 6 weeks, and be available via email or chat periodically throughout each day.
