


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

The final amount of each scholarship will be decided after we have the final number of scholarship applicants. **To apply for the FXAM conference scholarship**, contact Laureen Majeske (**Imajeske1@comcast.net**) and copy Sheryl Roman (**romanjsr@aol.com**) to let them know you are interested in the scholarship. Please mention in the email if you are applying for a scholarship for one or two family members and their names. Apply by Monday, May 2. By Monday, May 9, Laureen or Sheryl will contact applicants with confirmation of their scholarship amounts. If you have not registered by then, you'll have until May 18 for early bird conference registration. If FXAM is a part of the NFXF merchandise booth, recipients will be asked to work one or two hours during the conference. You will be notified prior to the conference and will have a choice of when you work. In late July, you'll verify that you attended the conference by submitting receipts (hotel, etc) and after verification, will be paid the scholarship money in early August. Each scholarship recipient will be asked to submit a short explanation of their favorite conference speaker. We'd like to schedule a great speaker for our 2017 Michigan conference! **NOTE**: *If you were awarded a 2016 NFXF scholarship, your FXAM scholarship will be a partial scholarship. If you were awarded a 2016 Rogers Neighborhood Family Fund Scholarship, you will still qualify for a full <i>FXAM scholarship*.


