**APPENDIX B  
NON-RECURRING CHARGES**

**Description of Charges**

<b>(e) Water Tap Fee</b>	<u>\$1,500.00</u>
<p>Each user shall pay a tap charge of \$1500 for a 5/8" or 3/4" meter to be set. If additional road cuts, boring and materials are required, the user will be responsible for those costs.</p> <p><b>For meters larger than 3/4", where allowed, user shall pay the tap fee and costs of the meter, materials, labor, road cuts and boring.</b></p>	
<b>(f) Sewer Tap On Charge</b>	<u>\$1,500.00</u>
<p>Each user shall pay a tap charge of \$1500 for a tap on to the sewer main. If additional road cuts, boring and materials are required, the user shall be responsible for those costs. Town employee must inspect at time of customer hookup to the main. Reasonable notice must be given for an employee to be present for inspection.</p>	
<b>(g) Meter Deposit</b>	<u>\$100.00</u>
<p><b>Property owners</b> shall pay a \$100 meter deposit that is refundable after 1 year of prompt payment history, or, after final bill is paid in full. If customer is late more than twice during the 1 year period, the deposit will carry over and a new 1 year period will begin.</p> <p><b>Rental Tenants</b> shall pay a \$100 meter deposit that shall be refundable after final bill is paid in full.</p>	
<b>(h) Sewer Deposit</b>	<u>\$100.00</u>
<p><b>Property owners</b> shall pay a \$100 sewer deposit that is refundable after 1 year of prompt payment history, or, after final bill is paid in full. If customer is late more than twice during the 1 year period, the deposit will carry over and a new 1 year period will begin.</p> <p><b>Rental Tenants</b> shall pay a \$100 sewer deposit that shall be refundable after final bill is paid in full.</p>	
<b>(i) New Owner/Renter Account Set Up Charge</b>	<u>\$25.00</u>
<b>(j) Late payment charge</b>	
<p>A utility service bill shall be rendered as a net bill. If the net bill is not paid by the billing due date, it shall become delinquent and a late payment charge may be added in the amount of ten (10) percent of the current bill due.</p>	
<b>(k) Reconnection Charge</b>	<u>\$75.00</u>
<p>An account with a past due balance that has not been paid in full by the 5th of the following month will have services disconnected. To restore service the full past due balance and the reconnection charge must be paid.</p>	
<b>(l) Insufficient Funds, Closed Accounts, Frozen Accounts, &amp; Uncollected Funds</b>	<u>\$33.00</u>
<p>Any payment by check or automatic draft returned for any reason will be charged a fee.</p>	
<b>(m) Service Call Charge during business hours</b>	<u>\$25.00</u>
<b>(n) Service Call Charge after 4pm, Weekends, &amp; Holidays</b>	<u>\$65.00</u>
<b>(o) Broken Lock Charge</b>	
<b>(1) First Offense fine</b>	<u>\$100.00</u>
<b>(2) Second Offense fine and possible removal of meter</b>	<u>\$250.00</u>
<b>(3) Third Offense fine and Removal Of Meter</b>	<u>\$250.00</u>
<b>(p) Parts replacement charges due to customer negligence or destruction</b>	
<b>(1) Collar &amp; Lid</b>	<u>\$62.00</u>
<b>(2) Meter Antenna</b>	<u>\$163.00</u>
<b>(3) Concrete Meter Lid</b>	<u>\$26.21</u>

Sewer rate is \$11.99 per thousand gallons and a \$3.05 base charge with the minimum monthly bill being \$27.03  
Sewer rate for Morgan School is \$8.81 per thousand gallons and a \$3.05 base charge with the minimum monthly bill being \$355.45
