

Song Title: That We Might Live Through Him *aka* The Savior of the World

Text: John 6:38, 40; John 17:5; 2 Thessalonians 2:16; 2 Corinthians 1:3; Psalm 23:3; Psalm 103:4; John 8:12; Isaiah 26:4; John 14:27; Psalm 16:11; 1 John 4:9 or 1 John 4:14

Summary: These Scriptures tell us that the Savior descended from heaven to earth to do Heavenly Father's will. The text celebrates the blessings we can enjoy, because of the Savior's obedience, as we try to follow Jesus' way and also do Heavenly Father's will.

Note: The final phrase may be one of 2 endings.

"The Savior of the World" ending is included to make this song more appropriate for Christmas if desired.

Brief History: The music for this song came first, and I struggled to know what words to use. Heavenly Father guided me to Scriptural texts which fit the music and I called it "That We Might Live Through Him." A few months later, we were working on the 2019 Ventura Stake Christmas Fireside, themed "Jesus, Savior of the World." By substituting the original final 5 words to match the Fireside Theme, the song matched the theme. It was a fascinating, spiritual experience. The decision was made to use the song as the final vocal solo, which was sung beautifully for the first time on December 15, 2019 by Kaleene Henn.
