

## **Privacy notice Maoz UK May 2018**

### **Introduction**

The purpose of this document is to let you know how we collect personal information (PI) from you, what PI we usually collect, why we collect this PI and how we protect your PI.

### **How do we collect your PI?**

When you contact us by:

- Requesting information
- Giving a donation
- Asking us to put you on our mailing list for the monthly Maoz report and/or for the Intercessors' letter

and supply us with your PI.

When someone gives us your name and address and tells us that you have agreed to our contacting you.

When you fill out a questionnaire at a meeting, conference or other event.

### **What information do we usually collect?**

- Your title and name
- Your contact details (postal address, email, phone number and preferred method)
- Bank account details if necessary for donations by standing order or direct debit
- Debit or credit card details for donating online or over the phone. We do not store any of these details.
- Whether we can claim Gift Aid on your donations.
- Your donation record.
- Any other PI you give us to help us to help you, eg prayer requests.

### **Why do we collect this information?**

- To record and process your donation
- To know if we can claim Gift Aid
- To know where and by what means to send you what you want (eg the monthly Israel report (MIR), the prayer letter, acknowledgement of your donation).

- To inform you about our activities
- To aid us in developing our relationship with you.

### **How we protect your personal information**

We take great care with your PI, never sharing it with other organisations for marketing purposes.

We take all reasonable steps to safeguard the PI in our possession, vetting and training staff, ensuring our records are kept in secure cabinets and never left unguarded on desks etc.

We never disclose your PI to third parties without your permission.

The MIR is printed in the USA and posted from the USA under the control of the Maoz International office in Dallas, Texas. Because the USA is outside the European Economic area and not subject to the EU data protection regulations, we have put in place a contract with the USA office to ensure they provide the appropriate level of protection. The same applies to email address lists.
