Announcements - Burgie mentioned about Mountain Mike's Pizza, where we used to go to on Wednesday nights, at this point is not available for up to forty-eight people, but twenty people could be arranged. No longer, all you can eat, but same selections. They are willing to take any date we select, between five to seven pm, on a Wednesday. Audrey suggested July 14th.

Club Picnic - Still up in the air about our September picnic, perhaps on Sunday September 12th. Meanwhile, put it on your calendar. Roger, KE6SZG, suggested that information be included in the Communicator.

Tech Report – Roger, Dj, KJ6DJ, and Howdie, KE6BEE, went up to the WA6KQB repeater site, and changed out the solar controls. Next job will be weed control and shed clean-up. They need at least five people to volunteer, decide on the time, and check what needs to be done. A lot of wires in the shack needs to be removed from the job Alan and Doug disconnected and left in the shed. We need to get the cavities off the floor, rewire, build a work-test bench, and generally upgrade to a professional level. Rotate the solar box around for easier access. Paint or replace floor, support beams, and check out what could be replaced or repaired on the joists. Not too big or expensive, original bid of \$3000, could be done for a lot less, and try to keep them as small projects. No need for outsiders to raise any flags or activities there. Need to contact Roger for access to the repeater site. All work to be done, must be submitted to the Board. Roger, Burgie, or Dj, must accompany anyone doing work at the repeater. Plan for when and how long before any work is to be done.

Finance – Audrey's finance report is in this Communicator.

Net Controls – Dj mentioned that we need more participation on all nets.

Board Memo – Changes to our standing rules to be voted on at our July 11th Zoom meeting.

Field Day – David, KJ6AAT, mentioned that EBARC is joining up with EMCOMM at Canyon Trail Park, in El Cerrito, and CCCC is welcome. They are planning for tables and supplies, and it will be located at the El Cerrito BART station.

Meeting adjourned at 10:38 am.
