Family Sacramental Ministry

For families considering participating in a sacramental preparation program, the following are the expectations:

- * Families are to be registered and active members in a parish, partnered within CoHort.
- * Families are to be attending weekend Mass at their parish regularly.
- * Children must have attended at least one year of religious education prior to Sacrament year, and attend 2015-2016 sessions, or be attending a Catholic school.
- * Sacraments are to be celebrated in their registered parish.

Confirmation/First Eucharist

Through the Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist we complete our initiation into the Catholic faith. Confirmation is the "sealing" of our Baptism as we are anointed in the Holy Spirit. In the Sacrament of the Eucharist we complete our initiation by being "in communion" with the rest of the community. We now are able to share in the fullness of our communal experience by receiving the sacred body and blood of Jesus Christ.

Reconciliation

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is a gift of the church that offers us God's merciful forgiveness and the spiritual power and grace to overcome what is not good in our choices and actions. This sacrament is intended to also help us in our efforts to heal our personal spiritual wounds. Preparation will be for parents and children.





Love is Our Mission: THE FAMILY FULL ALIVE

Catechists can benefit from reading the short Catechesis prepared for the World Meeting of Families. Here is a breakdown of the chapters:

- 1. **CREATED FOR JOY—**God made us in his image to share in his joy.
- 2. **THE MISSION OF LOVE**—Each of us have a mission to receive and show God's love.
- 3. **THE MEANING OF HUMAN SEXUALITY**—Our bodies reflect God's image, and through our sexuality married couplies have the opportunity to co-create with God.
- **4. TWO BECOME ONE**—Marriage is a sacrament between a man and a woman and reflects God's covenant.
- **5. CREATING THE FUTURE—**Marriage is meant to be fertile and welcome new life.
- **6. ALL LOVE BEARS FRUIT—** "All Love Bears Fruit" through other vocation in the Church such as the priesthood, religious life, and celibate lay vocation.
- 7. **LIGHT IN A DARK WORLD**—Families show the world how to live with compassion and love.
- **8.** A HOME FOR THE WOUNDED HEART—Families need to be sources of mercy and support.
- MOTHER, TEACHER, FAMILY: THE NATURE AND ROLE OF THE CHURCH—The Church is there to guide and protect families.
- **10. CHOOSING LIFE**—Be families with "lives of faith, hope, charity, joy, service, and mission."
