Range Rules

- 1. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE TO BE CONSUMED BEFORE OR DURING USE OF THE RANGE.
- 2. Check to ensure that no one is near or behind the range prior to shooting.
- 3. Eye and ear protection is required for all shooters and spectators within 100 feet of the Range.
- 4. Members are allowed 2 guests on the Range.
- 5. ALL GUNS MUST BE POINTED DOWN RANGE AT ALL TIMES. LEAVE THE ACTION OPEN AND UNLOADED WHEN PROCEDING DOWN RANGE TO SET UP TARGETS.
- 6. Only shoot at the direction of the back stop.
- 7. PAPER TARGETS and targets designed specifically for firearms only. ALL other targets prohibited.
- 8. Shooting airborne targets is prohibited.
- 9. Police all BRASS, LITTER, AND TARGETS prior to leaving the range.
- 10. No rapid firing. 1 second between shots.
- 11. No intentional firing at target supports, stands, or trees.
- 13. **Do not handle any firearm while someone is down range**. Guns are to be cleared, action left open, and benched/holstered before anyone goes down range.
- 14. Targets are to be placed so that all shots, including misses, will impact the backstop.
- 15. Minimum Shooting distances:
 - a. Handgun: 15 feet
 - b. Rifle and shotgun: 50 feet
- 16. Caliber restrictions:
 - c. Rifle: .17 through .30 Max bullet size: 220 grains
 - d. Handguns: .17 through .50SW Max bullet size: 350 grains
 - e. Shotguns: up to 12 gauge Shot restriction: no larger than #5 shot
- 17. Shotgun slugs are to be used for sighting in purposes only with a maximum of 5 shots. All other slug shooting prohibited.
