Irma Mary Winne, 93 of Caseville, passed away Tuesday, Jan. 3 at Four Seasons Health Care Center in Bad Axe.

She was born on July 2, 1901 in Belgium, daughter of the late August and Elodie Schamp. The family moved to Canada in 1910.

She married Cyril Winne on Jan. 28, 1920 in Canada. They moved to Detroit in 1923. He preceded her in death on Jan. 22, 1961.

The couple started Winne's Bar in Detroit in 1934 and she continued the business until she retired in 1976. Mrs. Winne moved to Caseville a short time later to live near her daughter.
