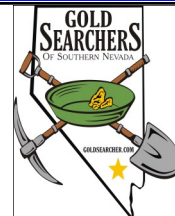
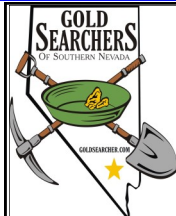

Minutes July 1, 2015

The GSSN met on July 1, 2015 at the American Legion Hall in Henderson NV. President John Anderson called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM and led in pledging allegiance to the flag. He welcomed all and introduced officers. (44 people signed in & there were 5 guests). John A. asked for a motion to approve the minutes from June 3, 2015 as published in the HighGrader. George Neiderriter made such a motion which was seconded by Richard Harding. All were in favor and the motion was approved. Treasurer Mark Hedges gave the treasurers report. Pam Goulder made a motion to accept the treasurers report as read, and Morris Seguin seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion was approved.

Everyone was reminded of George's Breakfast meeting at the Jokers Wild Casino on Boulder Hwy to be held on July 7, at 9:00 am. Red Rock Search and Rescue is looking for volunteers with metal detectors to assist the search teams. Email and contact information was provided if any members are interested in assisting Red Rock.

The next topic of discussion was regarding the potential of locating a claim in the Nelson Nevada area. Once an area is located and found to be unclaimed, a volunteer team will conduct test digs in the area to determine if it would be beneficial to file a claim in the area.

Two weeks from today (July 15) at 6:00 am we will meet at the corner of Rt 95 at Nelson Rd. and proceed to the area of interest. After a short break the meeting continued. *This event has been cancelled due to flash flooding in the area*

Our realtor contacted us regarding the 40 acre land purchase we have been working on. The offer now is \$ 17,500, seller pays for all closing costs. Buyer pays nothing toward the closing cost. The realtor has \$500.00 earnest money so the total cost now to the club will be \$ 17,000. The board feels this offer is a very good offer. A motion on the floor to authorize the Executive Board of Gold Searchers of Southern Nevada to purchase the 40 acre property ID # 337-XX-XXX located in Gold Basin, Mohave County, Arizona for the total price of \$17,500 with seller paying all closing fees was made by Richard Harding and seconded by Morris Seguin.. A hand count was held (33 in favor, 0 opposed, 6 abstained). The motion carried. The club will be kept informed on the status of the purchase.

A motion to adjourn was made by Pam Goulder and seconded by Morris Seguin and the meeting ended at 8:00 pm
